


# **TRADE AREA**




# More than 100 tourist attractions generated over \$2.3 billion in revenue for Oneida County in 2021.

- Tourism supports nearly 20,000 direct and indirect jobs in Oneida County, generating \$976 million in household wages
- There are currently over 100 tourist attractions in the area including:
  - Turning Stone Resort & Casino Located less than 10 minutes from the mall. Recently announced another multi-million dollar expansion, including a new 250-room hotel and convention and conference center. Groundbreaking scheduled for spring 2023.
  - Oneida Nation Enterprise opened The Cove, a vacation rental destination in Sylvan Beach.
     A \$35 million project featuring 70 two and three bedroom cottages for week-long rentals.
  - National Baseball Hall of Fame Over 350,000 visitors annually
  - Enchanted Forest Water Safari New York's largest water park. Ranked #4 on TripAdvisor's
- The Boilermaker, a world-renowned road race, is a week-long event in Utica, NY attracting over 45,000 participants and spectators from around the globe.
- Fort Stanwix National Monument's over 90,000 annual visitors spend over \$5 million in the Utica-Rome area. \$6.1 million in economic benefits are created by Fort Stanwix visitor spending.
- The trade area is home to 12 colleges and universities with a total student population of 33,087.













#### **UTICA UNIVERSITY NEXUS CENTER NOW OPEN!**

- Construction is complete on the \$67 million, 170,000 square foot Utica University
  Nexus Center a new indoor sports facility featuring three playing surfaces for ice
  or turf.
- The center will host ice hockey, indoor soccer and indoor lacrosse tournaments which are expected to bring 32-64 teams and their families to town in a weekend with recurring annual visitors estimated at 80,000
- Utica University Nexus Center is home to Utica University's women's hockey team and the Utica Jr. Comets hockey teams.
- Opened November 2022.














# **NANO UTICA**

Just 8 miles from Sangertown Square, more than \$2 billion is being invested at the Marcy Nanocenter and Quad C sites making the Mohawk Valley one of New York State's top technology hubs.

- 450 acre site being developed for semiconductor manufacturing and supportive nanotechnology. 5,000 additional jobs projected.
- Wolfspeed has invested \$1 billion and built the world's largest carbide wafer fabrication plant. Global transition to EV automobiles is accelerating and created demand for Wolfspeed's 200mm silicon carbide (SiC devices).
- Tech Barn is 42,000sf of commercial space and 232 apartments.
- Danish company, Danfoss Silicon Power, has moved into Quad-C and plans to add 300 new jobs.

- Utica is at the epicenter of an economic revolution sparked by advanced manufacturing and progressive investment strategies
- New York State is investing over \$885 million in the Mohawk Valley



1. Mohawk Valley Health System	<ul> <li>\$548 million investment</li> <li>4,000 new jobs expected</li> <li>50-60% of the hospital project complete. Slated to open July 2023</li> <li>MVHS received a \$50 million donation from The Wynn Family Foundation and the hospital will be named The Wynn Hospital</li> </ul>
2. Varick West/Brewery District	<ul> <li>\$2.5 million Irish Cultural Center opened. Includes a heritage museum, event center and an Irish Pub.</li> <li>Added a 18,000 sq. ft. outdoor Biergarten space in September 2022.</li> <li>A \$34.7 million expansion has been completed at F.X. Matt Brewing doubling its brewing capacity and creating 25-30 new jobs this year</li> </ul>
3. Central Business District	<ul> <li>\$925,000 investment</li> <li>New housing includes 31-unit modern loft development in former HSBC building</li> <li>\$10 million revitalization award from New York State</li> <li>Art Space Utica - a 41-unit housing complex for artists with commercial space on the first floor - has been awarded an additional \$4.9 million from the state. The entire projects expected to cost \$14 once complete in spring 2024</li> </ul>
4. Bagg's Square	<ul> <li>\$5.9 million investment to improve infrastructure</li> <li>Utica's oldest neighborhood and an up-and-coming mixed-use destination</li> <li>Plans to create a tourist destination including REA Wing Food Emporium at Union Station, expanded Utica Memorial Auditorium and a recently opened 30-loft apartment development in the former ConMed facility.</li> <li>Site work has resumed on the \$67 million Nexus Center and is expected to be completed by the end of summer 2022.</li> <li>60 apartments in the former Doyle Hardware building are now open</li> <li>Adirondack Barrel Cooperage (ADK Barrel) plans to expand and relocate. Plans are to build a \$3 - \$5 million manufacturing facility, restaurant and tasting room next to Adirondack Bank Center</li> </ul>
5. Harbor Point	<ul> <li>Masterplan includes a \$40 million housing development</li> <li>Developer to take over former 1933 building and build an additional building for restaurants</li> <li>2nd developer to transform 17 acres into mixed-use project</li> <li>Received grant to update promenade</li> <li>Expected to be complete in 2023</li> </ul>
